Why create an account?

With a College Board account, you can access your SAT and AP scores online, and send them to colleges. You can also register for the SAT and CLEP exams, and print your SAT Admission Ticket or CLEP Registration Ticket. Additionally, an account lets you manage your personal college list, save your scholarship searches, compare costs at colleges that interest you, and more.

Parent Information

Help your child navigate the road to college. Sign up for free College Board emails to get reminders and advice tailored to his or her grade level. Just select the emails you want to receive and enter your info.

Step 3: State Student Testing Number

This is not your student's Munster High School ID number. This is the official state number that is issued to students when they enroll in an Indiana school. If you log into the Student and Parent Portal in Power School, it is the number that appears next to your student's name. These numbers transfer with you if you move to another Indiana school.

Step 4: Importing Test Scores

Once you have the account created, you should be given an option to import previous test scores. If you do not see this as an option, please contact the College Board and share your personal information with them. Their representatives can migrate your scores to your account.

Step 5: Connecting to Khan Academy

Also on the high school's webpage are instructions for connecting PSAT scores to Khan Academy for individualized practice. Regardless of your score, there are 100's of sample questions that you can practice through the Khan Academy. Answers and explanations are provided, *and this program is completely free.*

If you don't have a previous PSAT test to connect, take the time to complete the online diagnostic, and the practice can be individualized to your performance on that diagnostic.
