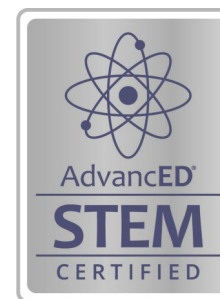

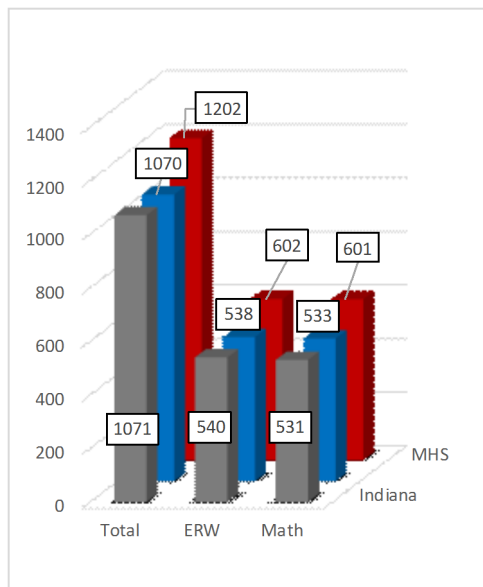

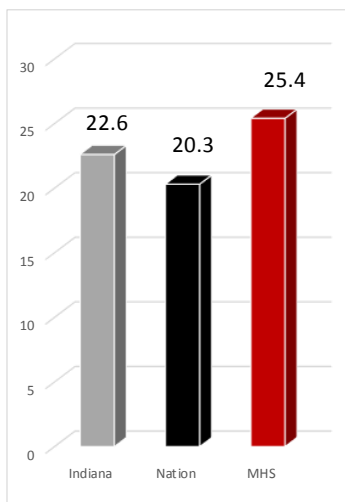
## 2017 SAT SCORES Taken by 55% of the Senior Class

## GRADE POINT AVERAGE

GPA is determined at the end of each semester using the final semester grade from each class. Grade points for regular and basic courses are awarded on a 4-point scale.
